# Proposed Security Upgrades

- Property and Space Committee (P&S) been looking at security upgrades for 2 years
- In Spring of 2023, WEE center parents expressed concern about the safety and security of their children
- P&S and others then began detailed discussions with two trusted local companies: Tech Electronics and Prep Security
- P&S visited a local company where an up-to-date security system was recently installed to see, first hand, the operation and features of a modern security system


### What these upgrades ARE and ARE NOT

- ARE for keeping unauthorized people out of the building
- ARE for assuring that all entrances are open when they should be, and locked when they should be
- ARE for monitoring the WEE Center children on the playground
- ARE for monitoring the property for damage or illicit / illegal activities

- ARE NOT for surveillance of people only for property
- ARE NOT a burglar alarm system

# Security Requirements

- Elimination of keys to KBC doors except emergency response.
- Remote locking / unlocking of all 7 exterior entrances, scheduled by calendar and / or time of day
- Detection of a door left open (not closed or latched)
- Exterior keypads (not key cards) at selected doors.
- Video Doorbell with intercom at two locations to identify individual requesting entry.
  - Welcome Entrance
  - Porte Cochere (car port)
  - Remote unlocking of these doors (by KBC staff) to allow entry of delivery drivers, repair people, others
- Include ADA powered doors at Porte Cochere (car port) for improved access by walker / wheelchair.
- Please refer to the next slide for an aerial view of the buildings, showing the 7 entrances, and the proposed security at each one



# Security Requirements

- There have been instances of theft and illicit behavior on our property
- Porte Cochere damaged without knowing who did it
- Cameras are external only. No interior cameras
- External cameras positioned high up at selected points
  - Monitor our property, children on the playground
  - Ability to capture video of illegal acts
  - Playground, parking lots, lawn and Porte Cochere covered
  - Not for surveillance not to be used to monitor people



## Security Upgrades

- After meeting with both vendors
  - It became apparent that only 2 of our 7 exterior entrances are amenable to modern electronic security equipment
  - 5 remaining entrances will require new doors
  - The additional cost for new doors was not anticipated
- New door benefits:
  - Modern security hardware is built in
  - Will match the 2 newest 6 panel doors giving a uniform appearance. Replace ugly doors
  - Allow more light into the building entrances.
  - New Porte Cochere doors will be ADA compliant powered doors, including manual controls.
  - Overall exterior appearance is improved.

#### Security Upgrades

#### Two Vendors

- Tech Electronics
  - \$155,855, including 10% contingency
  - Door replacements represent \$90 k of this amount
- Prep Security
  - \$119,000 including 10% contingency
  - Door replacements represent \$76 k of this amount
- Proposals are \$36,855 apart.

#### We are recommending Prep Security

- Lowest bid
- All the software is integrated into a single package:
  - Door locking schedule
  - Video door bell
  - External cameras
- Simpler management of security system

## Benefits to KBC

- Safety and Security for WEE center students and personnel.
- Safety and Security for KBC staff and the physical premises.
- Porte Cochere (carport) ADA entrance ease of entry for members using
  - Wheelchair
  - Walker
  - Crutches
  - Walking boot
- Staff will not have to make the rounds to check doors are locked / unlocked as needed.
- Avoid unauthorized people in the building
- Initial programming and follow-up of the security system will be done by Property and Space committee, KBC staff, and selected members of the congregation
